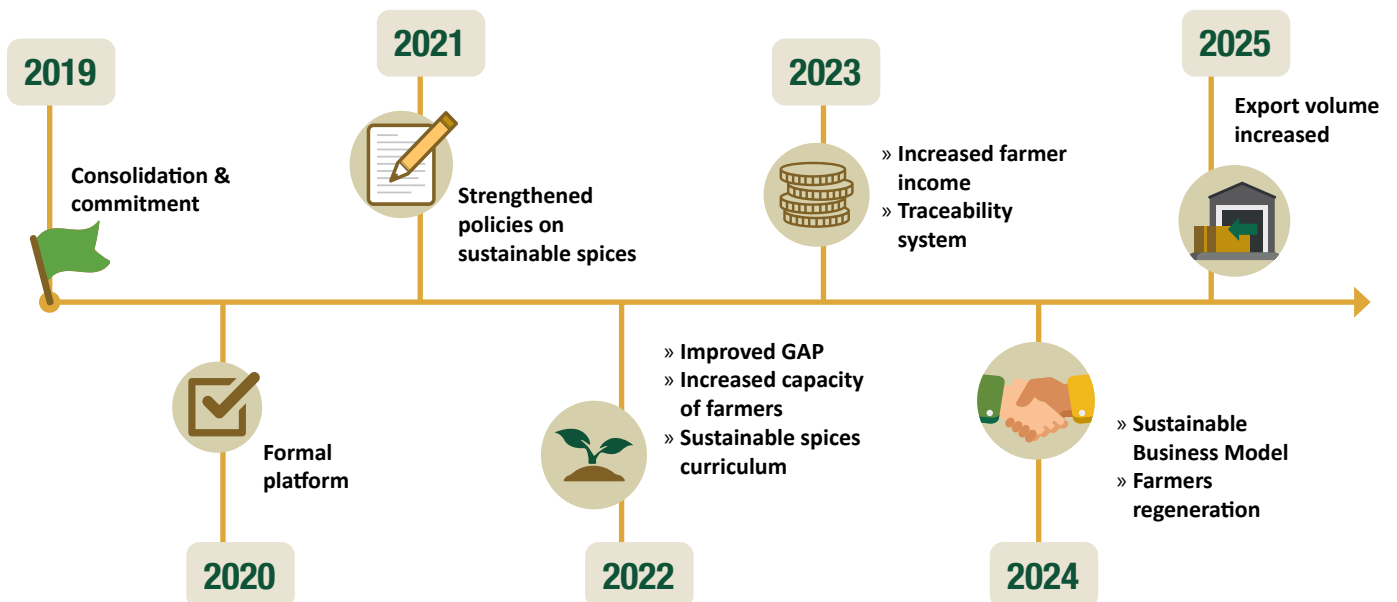
### What is SSI-Indonesia?
